HOW TO MEASURE FOR BLINDS

## Inside

- Mounted in the window frame
- Clean uncluttered look


Step 1

- Measure the inside width at 3 places: top, middle, and bottom.
- Round down to the nearest $1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$.
- Write down the smallest measurement. This is the ordering width.



## Step 2

- Measure the inside height at 3 places: left, middle and right.
- Round up to the nearest $1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$.
- Write down the longest measurement. This is your ordering height.



## Outside

- Mounted to the wall, ceiling or molding around the window
- Hides unattractive windows


## Step 1

- Measure the width at the top of the window.
- Add 4" to 6" (up to 3" for each side) to help eliminate light gaps
 and ensure privacy.
- Write down the total measurement. This is your ordering width.


## Step 2

- Measure the height of the window.
- Add 4" to 6" (up to 3" for the top and bottom) to help eliminate light gaps and ensure privacy.

- Write down the total measurement. This is your ordering height.

If Chadwell Supply is cutting your blinds, provide measurements of finals sizes needed; we will ensure your blinds and mounting hardware will fit and operate perfectly. Note: The width of the finished blinds or shades will always be a bit narrower than the width specified on the order.
